

### Britfestsm 2014

Dear British Car Enthusiast/Vendor:

I am the chairman of the MG Car Club Central Jersey Centre Britfest<sub>sm</sub> 2014 planning committee. The show is for British sports cars, motorcycles and other vehicles and will be held on Saturday, May 3, 2014 at Horseshoe Lake Park, Succasunna, N.J. Britfest<sub>sm</sub> is traditionally the first British car and motorcycle show of the season in the Northeast and has been held annually since 1992.

The show is very popular with British car and motorcycle enthusiasts. This event attracts up to 250 vehicles and 800 spectators annually. The show is a popular vote event, with trophies awarded in 20 classes, together with special classes for the People's Choice Award, President's Award and a Kid's Choice Award for the younger set who attend with parents and grandparents. Dash plaques are given to the first 150 entries. There are also automobilia and parts vendors, door prizes and food is catered by Tastefully British. Major sponsors have included Castrol, Jaguar and Moss Motors over the years. You can pre-register for this year's show using the attached registration form or go to our website to download same.
